Pre-guest arrival

Becoming infected with Covid-19 and further spread of infection (Hosts and guests)

to be included in booking confirmation email.

Requirements for safe travel and stay Ensure guests are emailed 14 days prior to arrival date to request Covid requirements. If a guest's temperature is above 37.8°C, they must not visit The Old Post Office Bed and Breakfast.

We are requesting that guests check their temperature before departing their principal residence.

Changes to day to day operations (to manage expectations).

Guest rooms and all public touch points disinfected. Disinfectant tested to BS EN 14476, BS EN 1276 and BS EN 13697. Where appropriate, all hard surfaces and soft furnishing steam cleaned at 2200W and 4.2 bar pressure.

Crockery from tea service will be washed at more than 60°C in the dishwasher and trays disinfected before and after use.

# WHAT ARE THE HAZARDS? Breakfast

#### WHO MIGHT BE HARMED AND HOW?

Becoming infected with Covid-19 and further spread of infection (Hosts and guests)

#### **EXISTING CONTROLS**

Two socially distanced tables in the dining room. Cotton table cloths and napkins will be washed at a minimum of 60°C if dirty or removed and replaced with clean for next booking. Tables and chairs steam cleaned for next booking.

# Ventilate breakfast room as much as possible, depending on the weather/temperature.

Pre-ordered full breakfast will be offered in the dining room on separate tables. Individual condiments/jams/muesli/granola to be provided on each table.

Containers to be washed at minimum of 60°C for next guests. Breakfast tables will be laid as guests come to the table and cleared. The same tray will be used to remove cutlery and crockery and before the service of a cooked breakfast. Trays will be sanitised after use. Each table will have its own tray.

#### **FURTHER ACTION REQUIRED**

Review guests for symptoms of Covid-19.

If a guest is displaying signs of the COVID-19 virus while staying in overnight accommodation for a permitted reason, they should inform the accommodation provider, immediately selfisolate where they are to minimise any risk of transmission, and request a test. If they are confirmed to have COVID-19, they should return home if they reasonably can. They should use private transport but only drive themselves if they can do so safely. If a guest cannot reasonably return home (for example because they are not well enough to travel or do not have the means to arrange transport), their circumstances should be discussed with an appropriate health care professional and, if necessary, the local authority.

Host will serve cooked breakfast in mask and nitrile gloves.

All jam jars, condiment bottles, etc will be sanitised for new guests.

		Dining room hard surfaces - table, any unused utensils, door handles, light switches - will be disinfected after the last guest has finished breakfast and has left the room. Chairs will be disinfected with Dettol All in One disinfectant spray (for soft furnishings) or steam cleaned.	
Housekeeping	Becoming infected with Covid-19 and further spread of infection (Hosts)	Housekeeping will be conducted by the host when the guests have departed for the day (PPE will be worn)	If any bodily fluids are found and laundry change or linen changes are required, the items will be removed in a dedicated linen bag and washed on-site at a minimum of 60°C
		Housekeeping will not involve making beds or tidying room	If dishwasher breaks down, items will be disinfected with disinfectant BS EN 1276/BS EN 13697 and then washed in hot soapy water.

If guest card transaction does not work, guest will be required to make payment by online transfer to host's bank account. Bank account details will be provided by guest digital messaging software. If a guest is unable to make an online transfer, guest will be asked to place cash in a sealed envelope. The envelope will then be quarantined for a minimum of 72 hours
Guest departure	Becoming infected with Covid-19 and further spread of infection (Hosts and guests)	Verbal reminder at checkout re left property. Advise unable to retain and return.	
		All linen, towels, robes, even if unused, will be removed in a dedicated linen bag for washing washed on-site at a minimum of 60°C or sent to our external laundry company	
		All items such as tea bags, coffee sachets, tissues etc will be removed and placed in quarantine for a minimum of 72 hours

#### **EXISTING CONTROLS**

**FURTHER ACTION REQUIRED** 

Deep clean and disinfection of entire room (all hard surfaces will be double disinfected with appropriate disinfectant EN1276/EN13972 or Dettol Multisurface All-in-One disinfectant spray (for soft furnishings), items such as TV remote control, hairdryer, kettle and coffee machine will be wiped down with disinfectant wipes (NHS approved). Curtain and blind pulls, door handles, light switches, etc to be sprayed with Dettol All in One disinfectant spray. Soft furnishings to be steam cleaned as standard.

Bathrooms steam cleaned at each changeover.

Bathroom toiletries must be cleaned and disinfected thoroughtly as the room is being cleaned.

PPE will be worn at all times during room disinfection and cleaning regimes

Room keys will be disinfected with Dettol Multisurface All-in-One disinfectant spray and left in the guest bedroom for next guests arrival

		Beds will be made up with clean uncontaminated linen wearing new PPE. Bed heads will be steamcleaned and disinfected with Dettol All in One disinfectant for soft furnishings.	
		Guest supplies replenished wearing PPE.	
External garden furniture	Becoming infected with Covid-19 and further spread of infection (Hosts and guests)	All chairs and tables will be disinfected daily and after guest usage at a minimum.	
		Any items in the table 'cube' that are used by guests will be washed in the dishwasher at a minimum of 60°C and returned to the table 'cube'.	
Books, magazines, visitor leaflets, maps	Becoming infected with Covid-19 and further spread of infection (Hosts and guests)	We will be unable to offer these amenities during this pandemic. They will be reintroduced in due course.

		Use correct PPE when stripping beds.	
		Have the linen bag ready for the linen from that room lightly secured.	
		Do not place used linen on the floor in the bedroom or corridor.
